

4.1 How to bid attending the auction

On the evening of the auction, Bidders must come to the registration desk which will be outside the auction room and complete a Registration Form by supplying such information as required by the Kapopoulos Cyprus. Bidders will receive a large card with a printed number on it ("paddle"). All lots sold will be invoiced to the name and address in which the paddle has been registered and cannot be transferred to other names and addresses.

4.2 Conduct of the Auction

Our auctions are public auctions which any person may attend. However, we do reserve the right at our sole discretion to refuse admission to or participation in any auction without stating a reason.

All lots are offered subject to a Reserve, which shall be no higher than the low estimate as printed in the auction catalogue.

The Auctioneer has discretion to refuse any bid, withdraw any lot, or re-offer a lot for sale, including after the fall of the hammer, if he believes there may be error or dispute.

The Auctioneer will commence and advance the bidding at levels and in increments he considers appropriate and is also entitled to place bids on behalf of the Seller.

The contract between the Buyer and the Seller is concluded on the striking of the Auctioneer's hammer, at which time the Buyer shall become liable to pay the Purchase Price.

5. HOW TO BUY IF NOT PRESENT AT AUCTION

5.1 Written Bids

If you cannot attend the auction, we will be happy to handle written bids on your behalf provided you follow the procedure described below:

1. You complete the Bidding Form found at the back of this catalogue.
2. This form should be used for one sale only and therefore you must indicate the date of the sale on the form.
3. Lots must be listed in the same order as in the catalogue.
4. In the Bidding Form you must record accurately the lot numbers, descriptions and the top hammer price you are willing to pay for each lot.
5. Bids should be submitted at least twenty - four hours before the auction.

This service is free and confidential. In the event of identical bids, the earliest received will take precedence.

If your written offer is higher than all other bids received, then your offer will be successful. Successful bidders will receive an invoice detailing their purchases and giving instructions for payment.

5.2 Bidding by Telephone

If you cannot attend the auction, it is possible to bid on the telephone. As this facility is limited, it is necessary to make necessary arrangements with us 72 hours before the sale.

We also suggest that you confirm a maximum bid to us which we can place on your behalf in the event we are unable to reach you by phone on the date of the auction.
